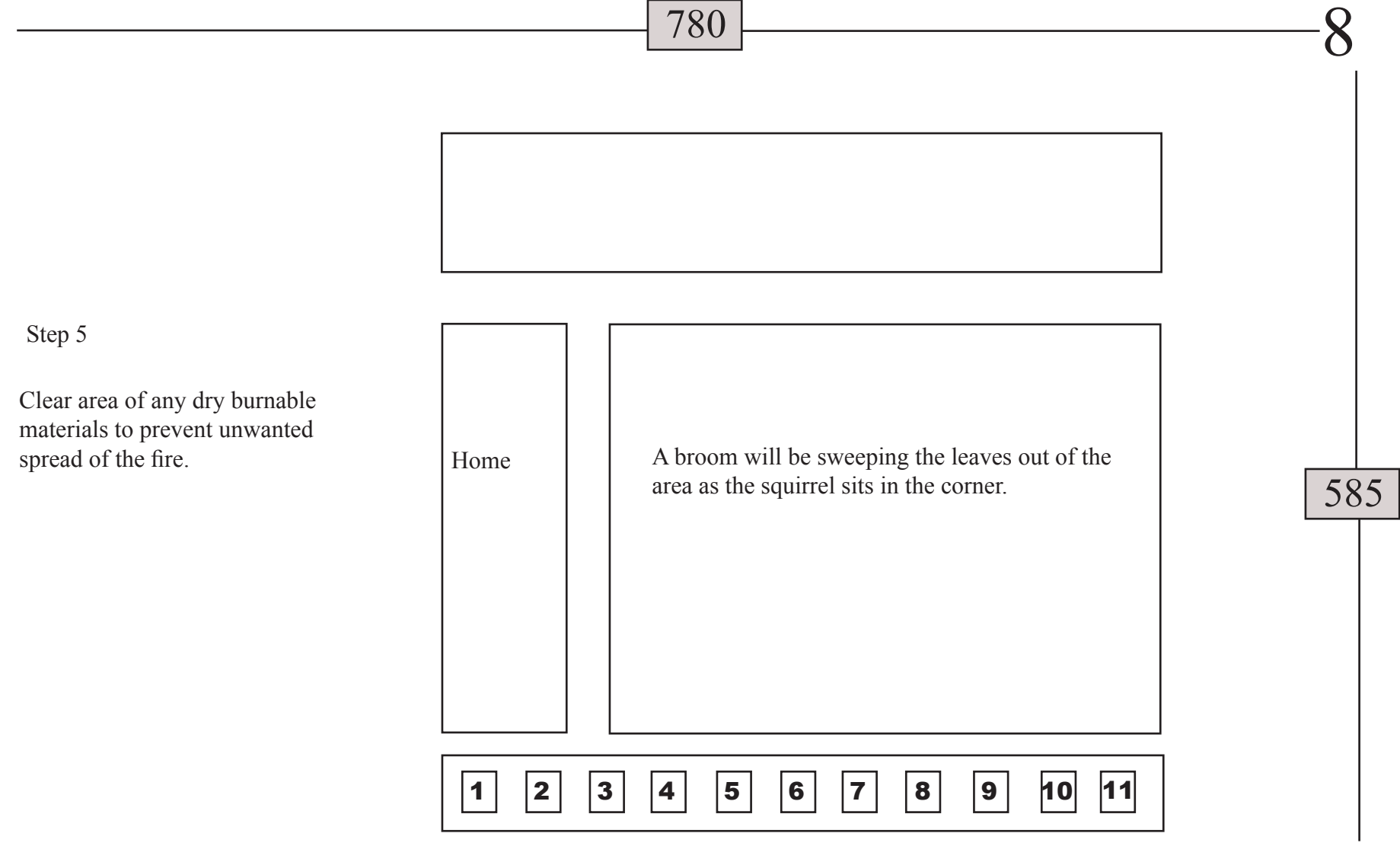
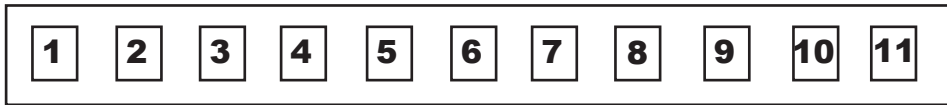


Step 4

A pile of sticks will be piling up. The squirrel will poke out from the side of the screen.



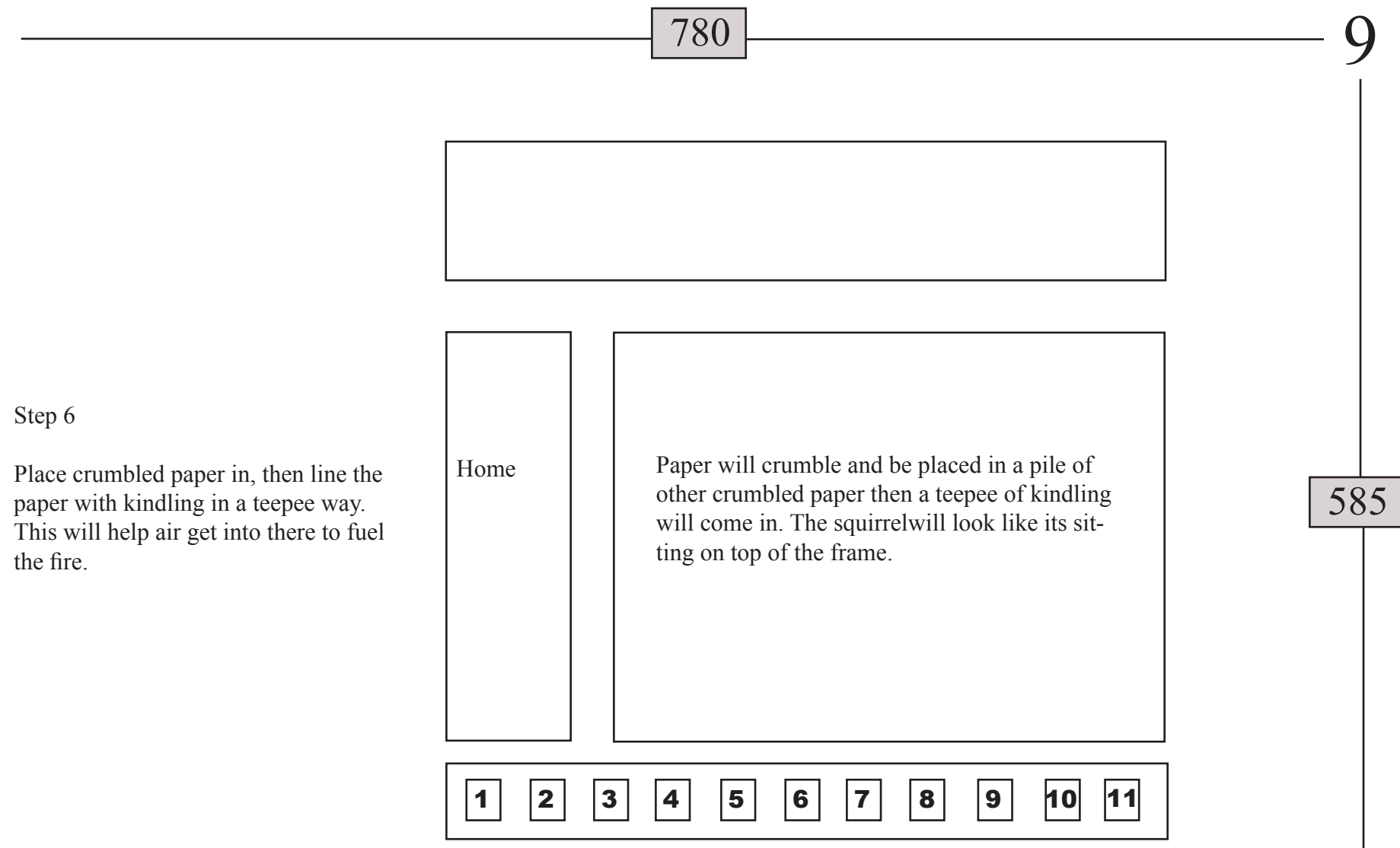
Step 5

Clear area of any dry burnable materials to prevent unwanted spread of the fire.

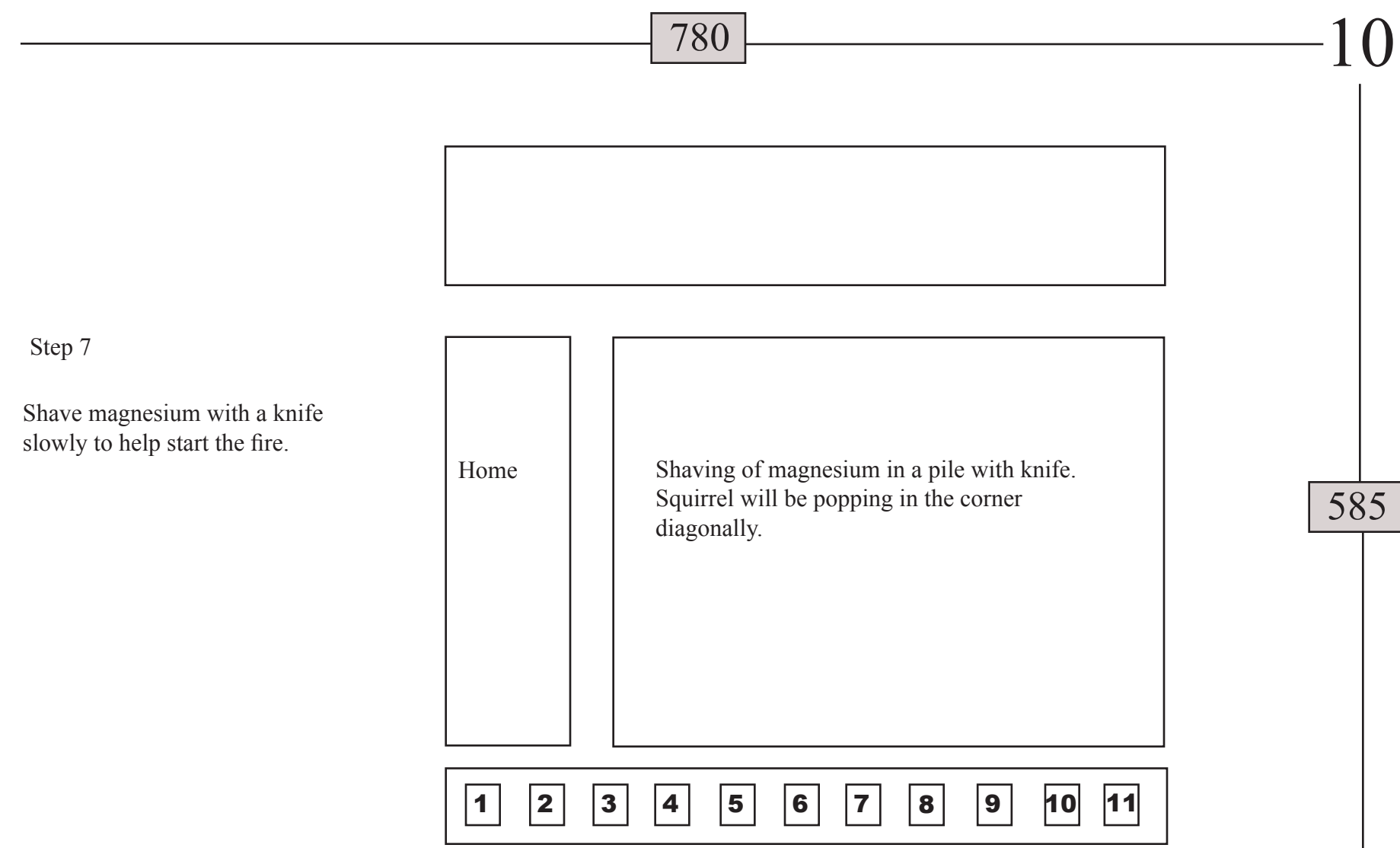


A broom will be sweeping the leaves out of the area as the squirrel sits in the corner.

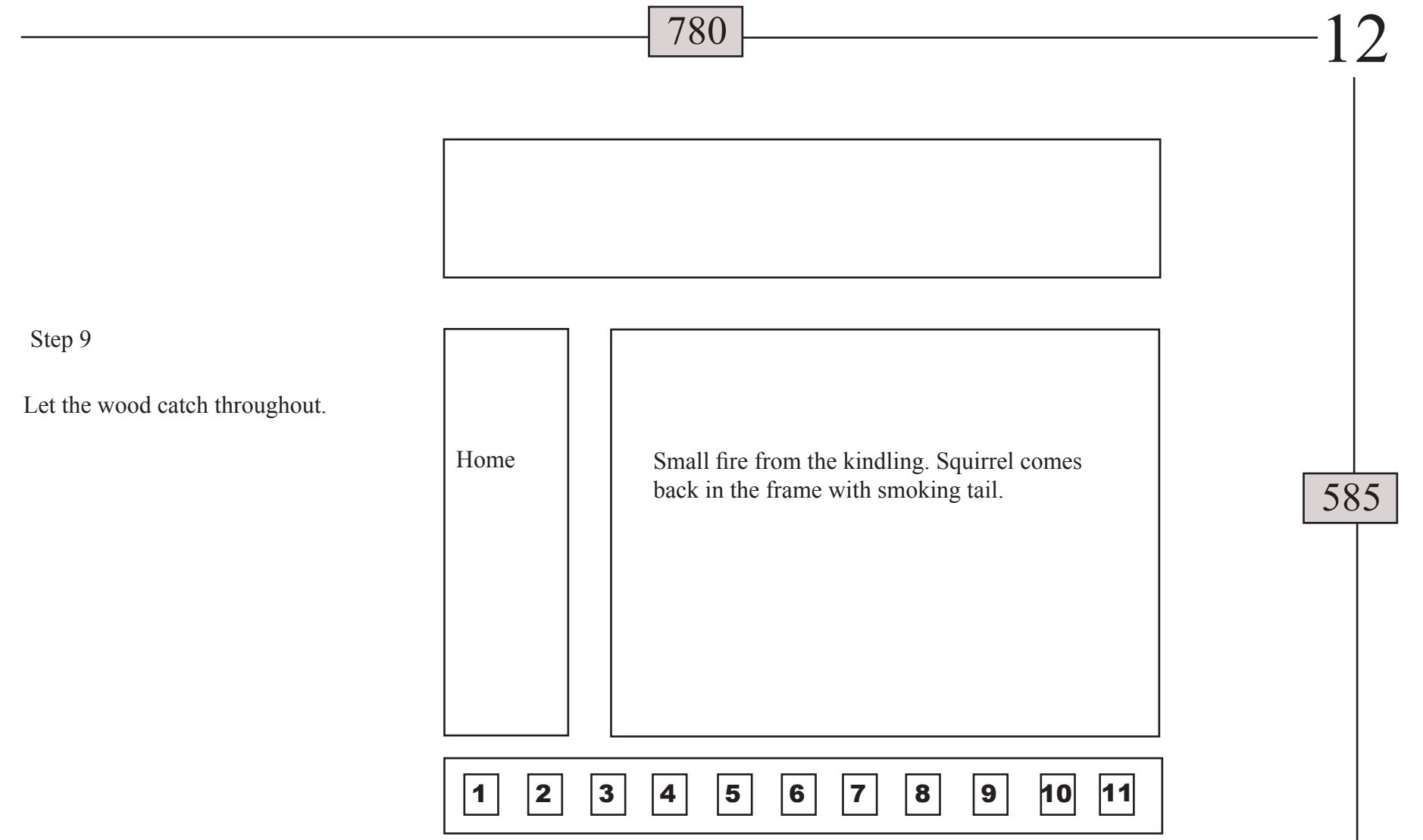
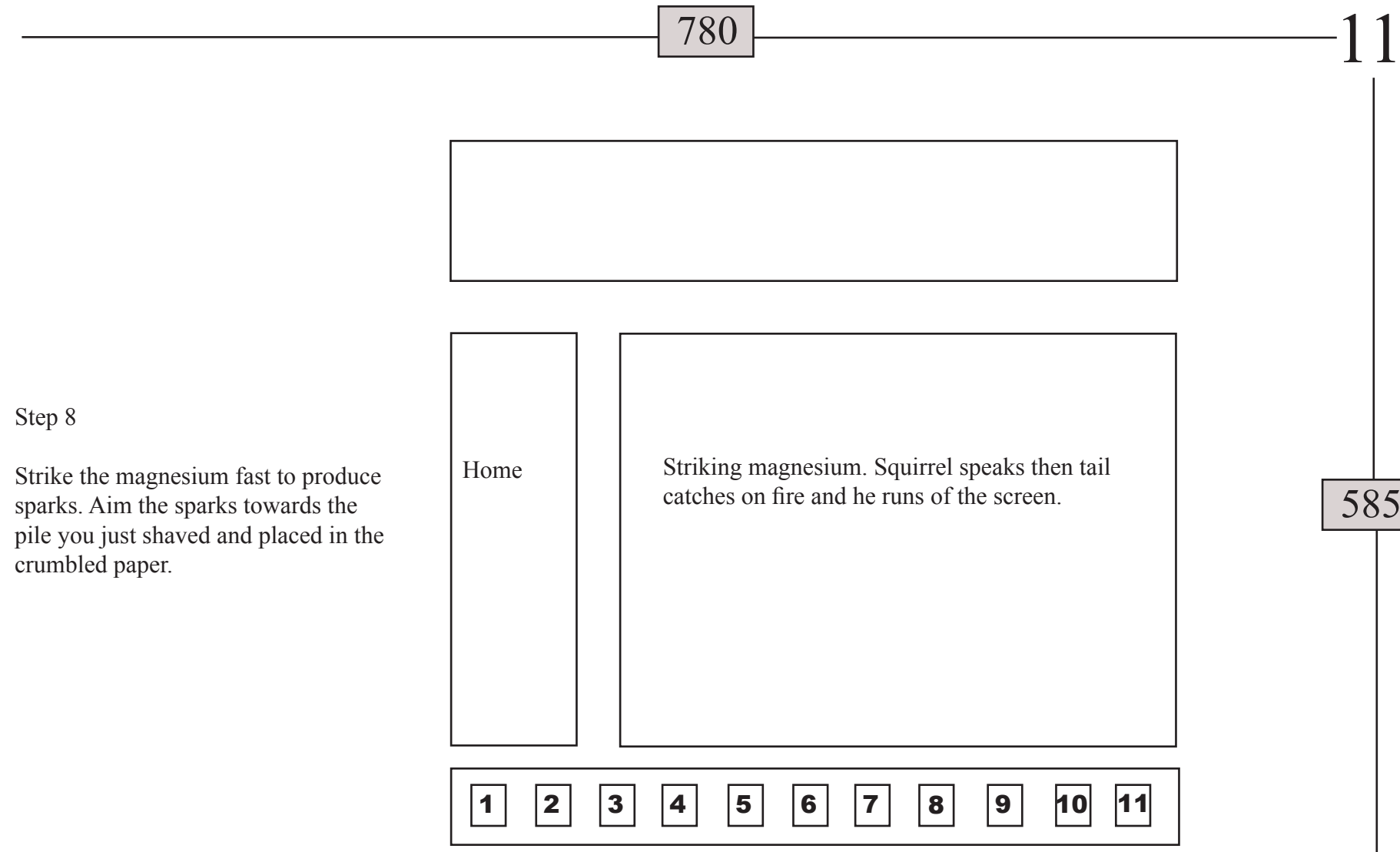


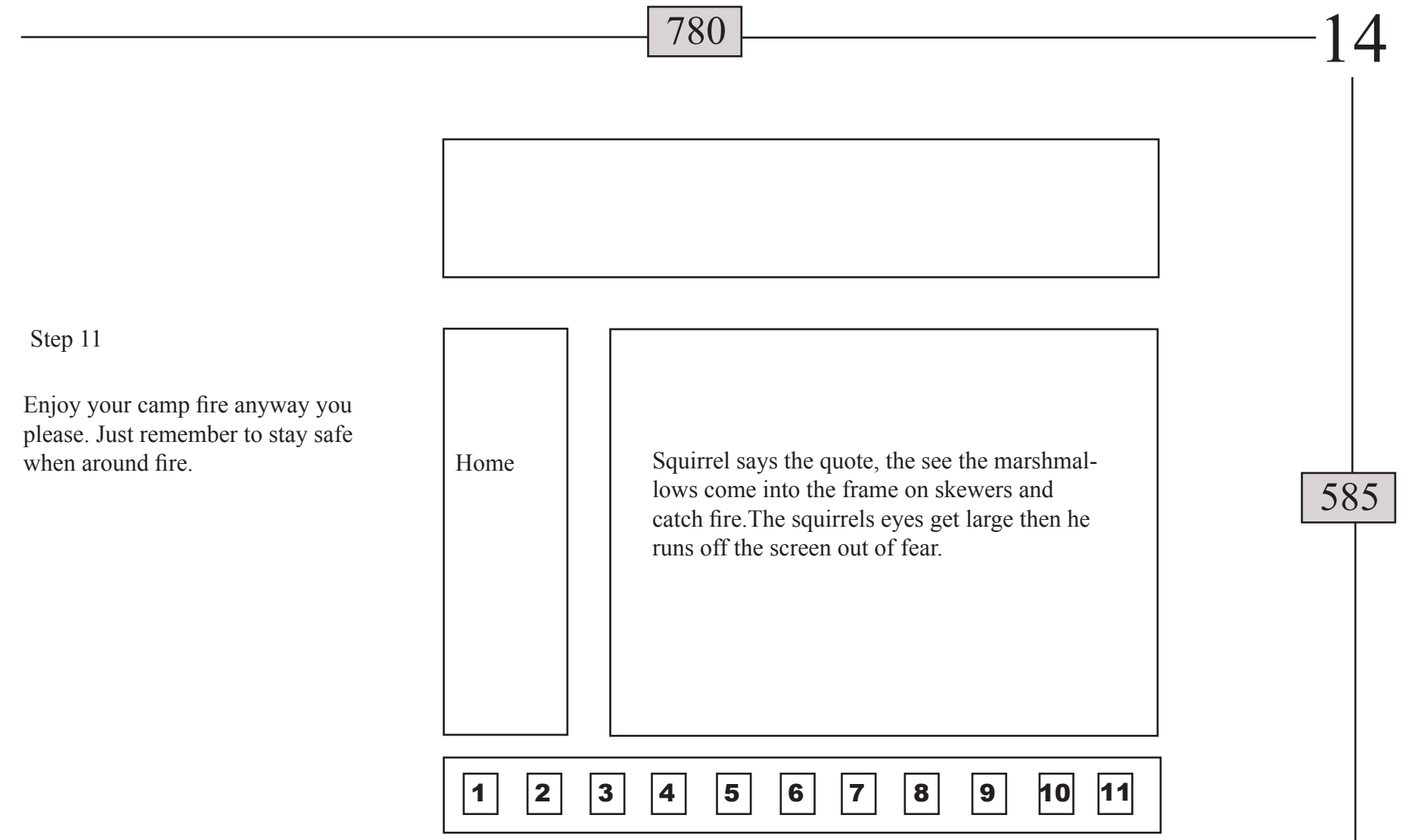
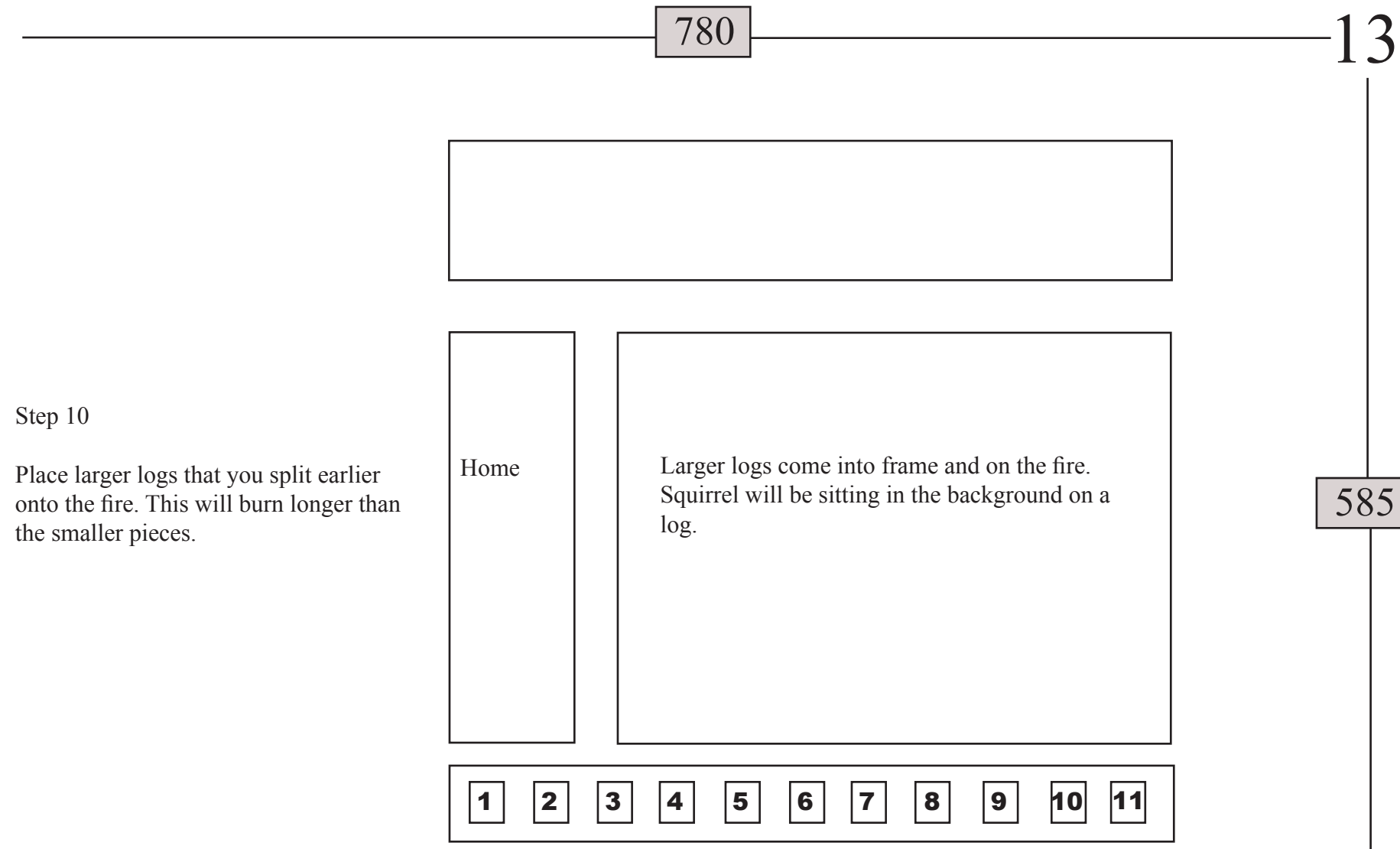
